General Assembly and Conference sub-themes are:

- 1) The change we need: Youth as leaders and change makers for modern adaptability to achieve and implement the Sustainable Development Goal 4 ("Ensure Inclusive and Equitable Quality Education and Promote Lifelong Learning Opportunities for All" (SDG 4).
- 2) Graduate women at the grassroots level: Localizing the SDGs through capacity building, awareness raising, outreach, community dialog, data collection, training and support.
- 3) Addressing general and systemic inequality in education; developing and influencing policy.
- 4) Beyond the basic skills (reading, writing and arithmetic): Promotion of education for peace, health, civics, culture and the arts, ecology, sports, social and vocational skills.
- 5) COVID-19: Compensating for the effects of COVID-19 on education for women and girls; how to adapt and move forward.
