Although this group is full, if there is enough interest in forming another one please contact Olga Shevchenko



Please join Guest of Honour Scott Jones and emcee Terry Mosher (aka Aislin) for a gala evening in support of their educational programs for the community.








This summer's Picnic in the Park had to be cancelled so many times due to rain that only the die hards ended up meeting one Friday evening.


